Brief Directions:

Page 1 (this page): Type an intro for the anchorperson to read before your actual voicer or wrapper is played; it should be able to stand alone as a flash story, with a good **lead** sentence and a **complete second sentence** that includes the **reporter's name**.

This should **NOT** repeat what is on the second page, and should also **NOT** use wording that is similar to second page.

Page 2 (next page): Type your actual story (the voicer or the wrapper). (This is the part that you will actually later record in production)

After the story on the 2nd page is typed, go to the last possible line on page two and write your outro, which must be:

"This has been (Your full name) for 107.9—FM News...." (You will read this as part of your produced story.)

NOTE: Delete heading labels and these directions when finalizing both pages.
